General: Based on observation during a tour of the center, the surveyor found that there were no lesson plans posted or available for review in the School-Age Room. Upon interview, staff confirmed that they did not have a current lesson plan for the school age children.

General: Based on observation during a tour of the center, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. The heating/air vent located on the wall in the School-Age room contained a thick buildup of dust.
- 2. The ceiling fans located in the Infant and Preschool rooms contained a thick buildup of dust.
- 3. Two (2) ceiling tiles in the Infant room located by the door were stained a "yellowish" color.

- (b) Equipped with hot and cold running water that allows for hand washing;
- (c) Equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit;
- (d) Equipped with liquid soap;
- (e) Equipped with hand-drying blower or single use disposable hand drying material;
- (f) Equipped with an easily cleanable waste receptacle; and
- (g) Immediately adjacent to a changing area used for infants and toddlers.

Findings:

General: Based on observation during a tour of the center, the surveyor found that there was no cold running water from the faucet in the restroom on the right located in the School-Age room; however, there was cold running water in the other restroom.

General: Based on observation during a tour of the center, the surveyor found that the toilet located in the School Age restroom was soiled. Through interview, staff stated that the toilet would be cleaned.

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found that the center's thermometer located in the upright freezer indicated that the temperature was twenty (20) degrees Fahrenheit; therefore, the frozen food was not kept at a temperature of zero (0) or below on the date of the surveyor's inspection.
