While the surveyor was waiting for children to walk to their classroom, the surveyor observed the broom to fall over and hit a child on the head; therefore, the health, safety and comfort of the children were compromised. **Director Requirements** In Compliance **Employee Records** Not In Compliance 435 - Training Not In Compliance 922 KAR 2:090. (17) A staff person's compliance with training requirements of this section shall be verified through the cabinet-designated database maintained pursuant to 922 KAR 2:240. Findings: General: Based on review of ECE-Tris and the personnel file of staff (DOH: 8/2/2018), the surveyor discovered that the staff had not completed one (1) hour of the fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training, that was required during the July 1, 2020 thru June 30, 2021 timeline.
