Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. Upon arrival at the home, the surveyor observed a fenced play area located at the side of the house. One of the fence posts was located beside the front porch. The fence extended to the other side of the yard. There was not a gate or way to access entry into the fenced play area at the front of the house. The surveyor asked the staff person in charge how access is gained into the fenced play area. The staff person in charge stated she stands at the end of the porch which is approximately 2 1/2 feet tall and lowers each child into the fenced play area. This is not a safe practice.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, this regulatory requirement was not met. During a tour of the kitchen, a can of Gerber baby formula was observed sitting on the counter. An interview with the staff person in charge found that the parents provide the formula for their child and do not bring the bottles pre-made. The staff person in charge indicated she does not participate in the food program and prepares the bottles by measuring the formula and water.
