General: Based on review of documentation, observation, and interview, the surveyor found that there were eight (8) children present at the center on 9/17/18 that were under the age of one (1) year old; however, there was not a sufficient number of individual cribs available to accommodate all eight (8) infants present. Review of the sign in/out sheets for 9/6/18 revealed that there were ten (10) children present on 9/6/18 under the age of one (1) year. The surveyor observed only seven (7) cribs in the center. Multiple staff confirmed through interview that the center only has seven (7) cribs. The Director stated that she thought it was okay to utilized one (1) crib for multiple children if the sheets were changed and the crib was sanitized between each use.
