Findings: General: Based on observation and interview, several cords were tangled and plugged into an electrical power strip on the floor in school-age classroom B. A six-year-old child played next to the cords and the electrical power strip. In addition, three (3) electrical outlets on the power strip were not covered.

 - 3. Commonwealth Child Care Credential as described in 922 KAR 2:250;**

General: Based on review of documentation, two (2) staff hired on 08/28/2017, and 10/29/2016 did not have education verification on file.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, a bottle of concentrated germicidal cleaner was labeled, "Keep out of reach of children" and was stored on top of a (4) feet high filling cabinet, which was accessible to children in the school-age classroom.

(1) First aid supplies shall:

- (a) Be available to provide prompt and proper first aid treatment;**
- (b) Be stored out of reach of a child;**
- (c) Be periodically inventoried to ensure the supplies have not expired;**
- (d) If reusable, be:**
 - 1. Sanitized; and**
 - 2. Maintained in a sanitary manner; and**
- (e) Include:**
 - 1. Liquid soap;**
 - 2. Adhesive bandages;**
 - 3. Sterile gauze;**
 - 4. Medical tape;**
 - 5. Scissors;**
 - 6. A thermometer;**
 - 7. Flashlight;**
 - 8. Cold pack;**
 - 9. First aid book;**
 - 10. Disposable gloves; and**
 - 11. A cardiopulmonary resuscitation mouthpiece protector.**

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, a first aid book was not in the first aid supplies.

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, a child enrolled 11/16/2020, did not have an immunization certificate on file.

(b) A written record for each child:

- 1. Completed and signed by the child's parent;
- 2. Retained on file on the first day the child attends the child-care center; and
- 3. To contain:
 - a. Identifying information about the child, which includes, at a minimum, the child's name, address, and date of birth;
 - b. Contact information to enable a person in charge to contact the child's:
 - (i) Parent at the parent's home or place of employment;
 - (ii) Family physician; and
 - (iii) Preferred hospital;
 - c. The name of each person who is designated in writing to pick-up the child;
 - d. The child's general health status and medical history including, if applicable:
 - (i) Allergies;
 - (ii) Restriction on the child's participation in activities with specific instructions from the child's parent or health professional; and
 - (iii) Permission from the parent for third-party professional services in the child-care center;
 - e. The name and phone number of each person to be contacted in an emergency involving or impacting the child;
 - f. Authorization by the parent for the child-care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, a child enrolled on 11/05/2020, did not have information on file for staff to contact the child's physician and preferred hospital. In addition, two (2) children enrolled on 11/16/2020 and 11/06/2020, did not have information on file for staff to contact the children's preferred hospital.

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the center did not have a written plan for evacuation on file, in accordance with KRS 199.895.
