(1) A person who is a child care staff member prior to January 1, 2018, shall submit to and complete background checks in accordance with this administrative regulation no later than September 30, 2018.

(2) A child care staff member hired on or after January 1, 2018, shall:

(a) Have completed the background checks required in accordance with this administrative regulation and found to have no disqualifying offense prior to becoming a child care staff member; or

(b)1. Have submitted to the background checks required in accordance with this administrative regulation;

2. Not be left unsupervised with a child in care pending the completion of the background checks in accordance with this administrative

regulation; and

3. Be dismissed or relocated from the residence if the person is found to have a disqualifying background check result.

#### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the director did not have a current out-of-state background check from the state of Indiana. Documentation on file for the out-of-state background check was dated 06/29/17.

General: Based on observation and interview, a large bottle of hand sanitizer was attached to a pole located outside the media room door, accessible to the children. Several large plastic garbage bags, located in a drawer, were accessible to the children in room 306. Two (2) staplers with staples were on a desk, accessible to children in the media room. A bottle of bleach water was stored in the bottom drawer located beside the entance of room 306. A large bottle of hand sanitizer set on the counter, accessible to children, at the entrance to room 306. A can of Lysol was stored in a cubbie in the toddler area.

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### Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, a large brown stain, larger than a basketball, was on the ceiling tile in room 306. Three (3) brown spots were on three (3) ceiling tiles in the hallway.

## 922 KAR 2:120. Section 10. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

(3) A sink shall be:

- (a) Located in or immediately adjacent to toilet rooms;
- (b) Equipped with hot and cold running water that allows for hand washing;
- (c) Equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit;
- (d) Equipped with liquid soap;
- (e) Equipped with hand-drying blower or single use disposable hand drying material;
- (f) Equipped with an easily cleanable waste receptacle; and
- (g) Immediately adjacent to a changing area used for infants and toddlers.

#### Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, the water temperature registered 126 degrees Fahrenheit at the handwashing sink in room 306. The water temperature registered 125 degrees Fahrenheit at the handwashing sink in room 316. The water temperature registered 140 degrees Fahrenheit at the handwashing sink in room 318 and the girls restroom located in the hallway.
