General: Based on interview with staff-in-charge, the surveyor found that the Type I child-care center has only one (1) qualified substitute staff person; therefore, the child-care center did not have the required two (2) qualified substitute staff persons for a Type I child-care center.

- (1) The premises shall be:
- (a) Suitable for the purpose intended;
- (b) Kept clean and in good repair;

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. A white sink cabinet in the Infant Classroom contained one (1) cabinet door that appeared loose/broken creating a gap between the two (2) cabinet doors; therefore, the sink cabinet was not in good repair.
- 2. The paint/finish on the bottom side of a white sink cabinet in the Infant Classroom was peeling; therefore, the sink cabinet was not in good repair.

625 - Floors, Walls, Ceilings Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

(9) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, in good repair, and constructed to be easily cleaned.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. A hole in the wall located beside the toilet paper dispenser in the girls' restroom measured approximately one-half (1/2) inch across; therefore, the wall was not in good repair.
- 2. A hole in the wall located under the window in the School Age Classroom near an exit door measured approximately one-half (1/2) inch across; therefore, the wall was not in good repair.

690 - Sink Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 12. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

- (3) A sink shall be:
- (a) Located in or immediately adjacent to toilet rooms;
- (b) Equipped with hot and cold running water that allows for hand washing;
- (c) Equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit;
- (d) Equipped with liquid soap;
- (e) Equipped with hand-drying blower or single use disposable hand drying material;
- (f) Equipped with an easily cleanable waste receptacle; and
- (g) Immediately adjacent to a changing area used for infants and toddlers.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. The hot water temperature at the sink located in the girls' restroom measured at a temperature of approximately 125 degrees Fahrenheit; therefore, the sink was not equipped with hot water at a maximum temperature of 120 degrees Fahrenheit.
- 2. The hot water temperature at the sink located in Preschool Classroom measured at a temperature of approximately 125 degrees Fahrenheit; therefore, the sink was not equipped with hot water at a maximum temperature of 120 degrees Fahrenheit.

- 2. Debris was located on the diaper changing table around the diaper changing pad in the Preschool Classroom; therefore, the diaper changing surface was not kept clean.
