General: Based on Observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The following was found:

1. During a tour of the school age activity room/cafeteria on the upper level the surveyor observed a metal shovel sitting beside the exterior door. The shovel was accessible to the children in the classroom.

2. During a tour of the indoor gross motor room on the upper level of the building the surveyor observed a phone charging base sitting on a small ledge. The electrical cord was observed dangling down towards the floor. It was not secure and was accessible to the children.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The following was found:

1. A tour of the one (1) year old classroom on side A found that the second drawer on the sink cabinet was broken. The bottom platform in the drawer was missing.

2. A tour of the one (1) year old classroom on side B found that the handle was broken on the top drawer of the sink cabinet.

580 - Floors, Walls, Ceilings

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. During a tour of the school age activity room/cafeteria the surveyor observed an excessive amount of dirt and grime accumulated on the tile floor next to the baseboards. Metal chairs were observed stacked on both of these walls.

General: Based on Observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. During a tour of the preschool classroom on the upper level of the building the surveyor observed a wooden refrigerator in the dramatic play area that was missing both handles; therefore, the doors would not open.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, and interview, this regulatory requirement was not met. During a tour of the one (1) year old classroom on side B the surveyor observed a plastic bucket sitting beside the hand washing sink that contained wet sippy cups and lids. The staff person working in the classroom stated that she had just finished washing the children's sippy cups from lunch. This process does not meet the requirement of the regulation.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The school age classroom had a schedule of daily activities posted that was dated December 2017 and was labeled "Winter Wonderland"; therefore, it was no longer current.
