- 3. Commonwealth Child Care Credential as described in 922 KAR 2:250;

General: Based on review of documentation, one staff member hired on 5/6/19, did not have proof of education on file.

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

(1) Child-care center staff:

- (b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:
- 1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or
- 2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the child-care center failed to meet this regulation.

1. Four staff had TB documentation on file that was obtained after their date of hire.

410 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and ECE-TRIS, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. One (1) staff hired 1/16/19, completed the six (6) hour orientation training on 7/24/19, which is after the ninety-day timeframe requirement.
- 2. Two staff hired 4/11/19 and 10/29/18, have yet to complete the six-hour Orientation training.
- 3. Four staff hired 7/25/18, did not complete fifteen hours of early care and education training.
- 4. One staff hired 7/25/18, has yet to complete the pediatric abusive head trauma training that is required within the first year of employment.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The following was found:

- 1. The men's bathroom upstairs, which is used by the children, contained three rusted metal partitions between the toilets.
- 2. The men's bathroom downstairs, which is used by the children, contained long, rusted screws exposed at the base of several of the toilets.
- 3. The women's bathroom downstairs, which is used by the children, contained a long rusted screw exposed at the base of one of the toilets.

580 - Floors, Walls, Ceilings

(9) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, in good repair, and constructed to be easily cleaned.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The upstairs women's bathroom, which is used by the children, contained a stained ceiling tile next to a vent.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. Three metal framed cars in the outdoor play area were sitting on blacktop. These cars contained bars that the children can climb on. Blacktop is not a protective surface for climbing equipment.

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

- (23) Fences shall be:
- (a) Constructed of safe material;
- (b) Stable: and
- (c) In good condition.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The chain-link fence around the outdoor play area contained two sections where the top metal railing was not connected to the fencing.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The back of a wooden cubby in the three-year-old room was broken and a hole was visible.

- (2) Indoor and outdoor equipment shall:
- (a) Be clean, safe, and in good repair;

Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The following items were found:

- 1. A shapes rug in the three-year-old room was stained around the edges.
- 2. A blue ball catcher on the playground was cracked and broken.
- 3. The Early Head Start Room (nine months to one-year-old) contained a sink vanity with a broken wooden drawer. The bottom of the drawer was not attached to the sides. This was the top drawer of the vanity.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The older school-age room contained a fish. The facility did not have written parental consent for the children to be in the presence of the fish.
