<p>Findings:</p> <p>General: Based on observation, this requirement was not met. During the investigation, the surveyor entered Room Three and observed one staff member supervising seven toddlers. The youngest child in the group was 12 months old. The surveyor waited a few minutes until another staff member came into the classroom.</p>

Findings: General: Based on observation, this requirement was not met. During the investigation, it was found that several staff members and children (ages two and up) did not wear masks as required by the Department of Public Health's emergency regulation (902 KAR 2:213E).
