Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following on the playground:

1. There was a Pepsi can located by the fence inside the playground. The children were able to have access to the Pepsi can.

Staff stated that the children had not been on the playground due to the weather.

2. There was a cigarette package located under the fence where the children had access to the package.

Staff stated that the children had not been on the playground due to the weather.

3. There were multiple broken toys that resembled a gear located on the playground. The surveyor took pictures of the broken toys for reference.

Staff stated that she would have them picked up.

4. There was a broken board that was used to keep the mulch off the walkway. The broken board had sharp edges.

Staff stated that the children had not been on the playground due to the weather.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found that the changing pad on the changing table located between Toddler I Classroom and the Nursery Classroom had a rip in the vinyl. Therefore, the changing pad was not in good repair. Staff reported that she was unaware of the rip in the changing pad.

815 - Toys/Furniture Not In Compliance

- (1) All toys and furniture contacted by a child shall be:

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the staff found the following:

- 1. In the Toddler I Classroom there was a blue vinyl round chair that had frayed spots where one sits in it. Therefore, the chair was not in good repair. Staff reported that she was unaware of the chair not being in good condition.
- 2. In the Toddler II Classroom the blue vinyl couch had a hole in it. Therefore, the couch was not in good repair. Staff reported that she was unaware that the couch had a hole in it.
