Findings: General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor was not presented with documentation of a negative tuberculin result or a statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis for a staff member (DOH: 08/05/19). During interview, staff (DOH: 08/17/18) stated that the employee had a current negative tuberculin result, but had not provided her with a copy. **Hygienic Practices** Not In Compliance 680 - Soiled Diapers/Clothing Not In Compliance 922 KAR 2:120. (8) Diapers or clothing shall be: (a) Changed when soiled or wet; (b) Stored in a covered container temporarily; and (c) Washed or disposed of at least once a day. Findings: General: Based on interview, staff (DOH: 08/17/18) confirmed that a two (2) year old child was sent home with a soaking wet diaper as reported. Staff (DOH: 08/17/18) stated that the issue was addressed with the staff person responsible for the child and no further incidents were reported.

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
