General: Based on review of documentation and interview, two (2) staff each hired on 8/7/18, had not completed nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early child care training. Staff hired 10/18/18 and 10/11/18, completed eight (8) hours of training. Staff hired 8/7/18, had not completed six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation training within the first three (3) months of employment. Staff hired 8/7/18 and 10/11/18, completed one and a half (1 1/2) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training on 12/6/19 and 12/7/19, which was past the first year of their employment.
