Findings:

General: Based on observation, two (2) school-age children were not supervised for approximately two (2) minutes when they left the cafeteria and walked approximately seventy-three (73) feet down a curved hall to the preschool room. A caregiver was aware of their departure.

General: Based on observation and a review of the documented licensed space, the center used preschool rooms 117 and 122 daily and did not have prior approval from the cabinet. During interview, it was confirmed the two (2) rooms were used daily.

General: Based on review of documentation, a staff, hired on 08/23/19, had TB documentation on file but no results were indicated.

General: Based on review of documentation, a staff, hired on 08/27/18, did not complete any hours of cabinet approved training during the first year of employment. Two (2) staff, hired on 08/07/18 and a staff, hired on 12/11/18 each completed one and a half (1 ½) hours of cabinet approved training during the first year of employment. A staff, hired on 09/27/18, a staff, hired on 10/10/18, and a staff, hired on 11/26/18, each completed two (2) hours of cabinet approved training during the first year of employment. A staff, hired on 10/30/18, completed six (6) hours of cabinet approved training during the first year of employment. A staff, hired on 10/30/18, completed one and a half (1 ½) hours of cabinet approved pediatric abusive head trauma on 11/22/19, which was not within the first year of employment. A staff, hired on 10/10/18, completed one and a half (1 ½) hours of cabinet approved pediatric abusive head trauma on 11/12/19, which was not within the first year of employment. The daily attendance records for the week of 09/30/19, did not include a documented arrival time for approximately thirty-one (31) children and a documented departure time for two (2) children.
