## 922 KAR 2:090, Section 9, Records

- (1) A child-care center shall maintain:
- (e) A current personnel file for each child-care center staff person to include:
- 1. Name, address, date of birth, and date of employment;
- 2. Proof of educational qualifications;
- 3. Record of annual performance evaluation;
- 4. Documentation of compliance with tuberculosis screening in accordance with Section 11(1)(b) of this administrative regulation; and
- 5. The results of background checks conducted in accordance with 922 KAR 2:280;

### Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, a staff member was present in the gym with four children, this staff member did not have a file at the facility. The staff person in charge stated that this individual was a substitute from another facility, as the staff member scheduled to work had called in. The surveyor was able to determine via the KARES Fingerprint portal that this individual was eligible for employment on 9/7/2021. This individual did not have records of educational requirements, a negative tuberculin skin result, or a documented date of hire. In addition, other identifying information such as name, address, and date of birth could not be determined due to staff file not being present.

# 400 - Educational Requirements 922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (1) Child-care center staff:
- (a) Hired after January 1, 2009, who have supervisory power over a minor and are not enrolled in secondary education, shall have a:
- 1. High school diploma:
- 2. GED or qualifying documentation from a comparable educational entity; or
- 3. Commonwealth Child Care Credential as described in 922 KAR 2:250;

## Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, a staff member with an unknown date of hire did not have proof of educational qualifications available for review.

- 1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or

#### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, a staff member with an unknown date of hire did not have documentation of a negative tuberculin skin result, nor a physician's statement clearing this individual of active tuberculosis.

- (6) In addition to the posting requirement of KRS 199.898(3), a child-care center shall post the following in a conspicuous place and make available for public inspection:
- (a) The provider's preliminary or regular license;
- (b) Each statement of deficiency and civil penalty notice issued by the cabinet during the current licensure year;
- (c) Each plan of correction submitted by the child-care center to the cabinet during the current licensure year;
- (d) Information on the Kentucky Consumer Product Safety Program and the program's Web site as specified in KRS 199.897;
- (e) A description of services provided by the child-care center, including:
- 1. Current rates for child care; and
- 2. Each service charged separately and in addition to the basic rate for child care;
- (f) Minimum staff-to-child ratios and group size established in 922 KAR 2:120; and
- (g) Daily planned program.

#### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the statement of deficiency and corresponding plan of correction from the 2020 licensure year was not posted nor available for public inspection.
