Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the provider failed to maintain first aid certification for a person on duty and present with children who applied first aid to a child. A child was injured on 9/7/2021 at 9:30 a.m. The staff person on duty provided first aid but had an expired first aid certification card. The certification expired 5/6/21.
