- (c) Be periodically inventoried to ensure the supplies have not expired;
- (d) If reusable, be:

- 2. Maintained in a sanitary manner; and

General: Based on observation and interview, the child care center failed to comply with the regulatory requirements regarding first aid/or medication. Observation of the first aid supplies revealed that a CPR Mouthpiece was not presented. Upon request, the staff member in charge did not present a CPR Mouthpiece at the time of the survey.

General: Based on observation, the child care center failed to maintain an outdoor play area in accordance with regulatory requirements. There was a large space between the bottom of the wooden fence and ground in the outside play area.
