General: Based on observation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain food service in accordance with regulatory requirements. Observation of the refrigerator in the infant room revealed there were no bottles for the two (2) infants present. Interview with a staff member revealed the parents provide the powder formula in a canister and water premeasured in the bottle. The staff member prepares the bottles by mixing the formula and water.
