- (2) A child care staff member hired on or after April 1, 2018, shall:
- (a) Have completed the background checks required in accordance with this administrative regulation and been found to have no disqualifying offense prior to becoming a child care staff member; or
- (b)1. Have submitted to the background checks required in accordance with this administrative regulation;
- 2. Not be left unsupervised with a child in care pending the completion of the background checks in accordance with this administrative regulation: and
- 3. Be dismissed or relocated from the residence if the person is found to have a disqualifying background check result.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found that a staff (DOH: 10/01/18) file did not contain a completed Criminal Records background check. The staff file only contained an original Child Abuse/Neglect background check dated for 09/25/18. During interview, the Director stated that the staff member was a floater and that the staff member has not worked alone with children. The surveyor did not observe the staff member working alone with children. A review of the Kentucky National Background Check Program revealed the staff person did not have a completed background check.

- 2. A staff's (DOH: 10/01/18) file did not contain a written performance evaluation.

Through interview with the Director, the surveyor learned that the written performance evaluations were not available for review.

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found that none of the center staff possessed current certification in CPR/First Aid. Through interview with the Director, the surveyor learned that the documentation was not available for review.

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found four (4) floor tiles that were chipped in the Infant Classroom,

- (2) A toilet room shall:
- (a) 1. Be provided for each gender; or
- 2. A plan shall be implemented to use the same toilet room at separate times;
- (b) Have a supply of toilet paper; and
- (c) Be cleaned and disinfected daily.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found that the floor tiles located beside the toilet in the bathroom of the Preschool Classroom were soiled with what appeared to be urine. The Director stated that she was not aware of the floor tiles being soiled and would have them cleaned.

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. A child's (DOE: 05/28/20) file did not contain a contact telephone number for the child's preferred family physician.
- 2. A child's (DOE: 01/21/21) file did not contain a contact telephone number for the child's preferred family physician.
- 3. A child's (DOE: 01/21/21) file did not contain the name of a preferred hospital or contact telephone number.
- 4. A child's (DOE: 01/21/21) file did not contain an authorization form for the child care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence.

- 2. A staff's (DOH: 06/01/19) file contained a professional development plan dated for 11/01/19; therefore, the plan was not completed annually.
- 3. A staff's (DOH: 09/11/18) file contained a professional development plan dated for 11/01/18; therefore, the plan was not completed annually.
- 4. A staff's (DOH: 09/07/18) file did not contain a professional development plan.
- 5. A staff's (DOH: 10/01/18) file did not contain a professional development plan.

Through interview with the Director, the surveyor learned the professional development plans were not available for review.
