Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, staff-to-child ratios were not maintained. On 8/31/2021, at approximately 10:27 a.m., the surveyor observed several children and one staff person on the playground. The surveyor approached the playground and counted 18 children. The staff person informed the surveyor that the children present were ages threeto five-years-old. She acknowledged that she was over-ratio by six children. She explained that she had been over-ratio for approximately five minutes because a second staff person was in the restroom. The second staff person returned to the playground as the surveyor entered the child-care center.
