#### Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, staff-to-child ratios were not maintained at the center from 7:30 am until 8:28 am on 07/12/19. A caregiver was left alone and supervised eight (8) children, infant through preschool, from 7:30 am until 7:35 am in the large room. The total number of children increased, from eight (8) to eleven (11) with the ages of children ranging from infant through school-age, by 7:50 am. The caregiver then supervised the eleven (11) children, aged infants through school age, from 7:50 am to 8:28 am, A caregiver arrived at 8:28 am to assist.

#### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the daily attendance records for the week of 07/08/19 did not have a documented departure time for two (2) children and did not have a parent signature to verify accuracy of the weekly attendance for three (3) children in accordance with Child Care Assistance Program.
