Due to the current declared public health emergency caused by the Novel Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19), licensed child care centers must operate under Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and public health guidelines, as mandated by 922 KAR 2:410E, to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, the center failed to assure that machine washable toys shall not be used and all child care staff, directors, owners, and operators shall complete a new, mandatory training on cleaning, sanitizing, health procedures, and mandatory reporting prior to the date of reopening, in accordance with 922KAR2:410E. Surveyor observed two (2) fabric purses for the children to play with in the dress up area in the preschool room. In addition, a caregiver hired 10/23/18, did not have documentation of completing the mandatory training.
