General: Based on review of documentation, one staff file (hire date: 1/31/19) contained results of a negative T.B. test that is no longer current. The test was dated 8/7/19, which exceeds the two year time frame.

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, this regulatory requirement was not met. At the time of the survey, it was found that the staff person in charge identified herself as the only substitute staff person and indicated that she was in process of hiring a second substitute.

- (c) Use hand sanitizer or hand-sanitizing wipes if liquid soap and warm running water are not available in accordance with paragraph (b) of this subsection. The child shall wash the child's hands as soon as practicable once liquid soap and warm running water are available.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the facility failed to ensure children's hands are washed with liquid soap and warm running water prior to eating. The surveyor observed staff gather the children enrolled in the afterschool program in the main hallway and then escort the children into the cafeteria. Children were instructed to pick up their snack on the way in and then sit in their assigned seat. The children sat down and began eating without washing their hands.
