## Findings:

General: Based on observation, two (2), one (1) inch by one (1) inch sections were missing on the corner of two (2) ceiling tiles in the infants' room. An approximately three (3) inch linear section was missing from a ceiling tile in the one and two-year-olds' room. An approximately five (5) inch crack was in a ceiling tile and covered with white tape in the one and two-year-olds' room, indoor gross motor room and school-age room. A small brown circular stain was on a ceiling tile in the kitchen. Dark fingerprints and shoe prints were on approximately twenty-five (25) ceiling tiles in the infants' room.
