A caregiver, hired on 12/19/19, had TB documentation on file dated 8/21/18. A caregiver, hired on 11/15/18, had TB documentation on file dated 1/21/20. A caregiver, hired on 7/1/19, had TB documentation on file that did not have a read date.

A caregiver hired on 2/1/19, completed two (2) hours of training during a subsequent year of employment. A caregiver hired on 4/13/19, did not complete any hours of training during a subsequent year of employment. Two (2) caregivers hired on 12/18/18 and 12/19/19, each completed twelve (12) hours of training during a subsequent year of employment. A caregiver hired on 11/18/21, did not complete six (6) hours of cabinet approved orientation training within the first three (3) months of employment. Also, three (3) caregivers hired on 2/12/19, 7/1/19 and 9/21/19, did not completed Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma training.
