3. An epinephrine auto-injector. A licensed child-care center shall comply with KRS 199.8951 and 311.646, including:

a. An epinephrine auto-injector shall be inaccessible to a child:

b. A child-care center shall have at least one (1) person onsite who has received training on the administration of an epinephrine auto-injector if the child-care center maintains an epinephrine auto-injector;

4. An emergency or rescue medication for a child in care, such as medication to respond to diabetic or asthmatic condition, as prescribed by the child's physician. Emergency or rescue medication shall be inaccessible to a child in care;

(b) Kept in the original bottle; and

(c) Properly labeled.

(7) Medication shall not be given to a child if the medication's expiration date has passed.

General: Based on observation and interview, an eight (8) ounce bottle of amoxicillin was not labeled to indicate for whom it was intended. The medication was stored in the medication box located in the refrigerator. This medication had an expiration date of 09/25/18.

General: Based on observation, seven (7) children were asleep on cots, on the floor in the two-year-olds' classroom. The cots were seven (7) inches to nine(9) inches apart.

General: Based on observation, a Baby Einstein Activity Jumper was soiled and stained and the seat was torn in the infant's classroom. A four-month-old child was placed in a Take Along Swing and the safety straps were not being used in the infants' room. Also, a three-month-old infant was placed in a Fisher Price Rocker and the safety straps were not being used in the infants' room.
