## Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, the child care center failed to comply with regulatory background check requirements in accordance with emergency regulations. Upon request, the child care center failed to provide completed background check information for a staff person with a hire date of 10/30/2020. There was no evidence a Child Abuse/Neglect Check for the staff person was submitted. Interviews also revealed the staff person had supervisory control of children, however, was never left alone.
