(3)(a) Each center shall maintain a child-care program that assures each child shall be:

1. Provided with adequate supervision at all times by a qualified staff person who ensures the child is:

a. Within scope of vision and range of voice; or

b. For a school-age child, within scope of vision or range of voice;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, observation and interview, this regulatory requirement was not met. The facility reported that on 5/4/22, a two year old child was left unattended on the playground for approximately eight minutes. A review of the facility accident/incident report during the investigation found the following information: At approximately 4:56PM, a team member was preparing for departure when she looked outside and noticed the child alone on the playground. She immediately retrieved the child and took her to the office. The child was not injured and did not appear to be upset in any way. The staff person in charge returned the child to her classroom. The staff person working in the classroom was unaware that the child had been left outside on the playground. The staff person was terminated as a result of the incident.

The staff person stated during interview that she forgot to do a head count when she brought her group of children inside from the playground and accidentally left the child outside.

The surveyor toured area during the investigation and found that the playground is located inside of the facility and is surrounded by the facility walls; therefore, the child did not have access to the public or traffic. The window where the child was observed standing when she was found is located beside the door the classroom uses to enter/exit the playground area. Furthermore, the child's classroom door is located directly across the hall from the playground door. They are approximately 10 feet apart.
