- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

#### Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, the presented staff files failed to verify that staff members with hire dates 08/10/2011, 03/08/2017 and 05/01/2017 did complete fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training. Review of the ECE-TRIS report did not verify that the training hours had been completed. Interview with the staff in charge revealed she was not able to verify the training hours were completed.

General: Based on observation of the restroom located off the main hallway, there was a stall wall adjacent to a sink that revealed rust and flaking paint. Observation of the restroom located off the Endevor hallway revealed a stall wall that was rusted and flaking paint.
