General: Based on observation, the surveyor found an air purifier cord plugged into an outlet behind a blue child sized couch in Classroom B. During interview, staff-in-charge stated that Classroom B was shut down due to COVID and was not currently being used by children.

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found two (2) drawers in a cabinet by the sink that contained child safety locks in Classroom A; however, the drawers opened wide enough exposing the following items at the front of the drawer: a screwdriver, a pair of scissors, push pin tacks, and one (1) bolt with a flat end.

## Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. A blue runner rug that contained debris located in front of an exit door in the Head Start B Classroom; therefore, the rug was not kept clean.
- 2. A square volcano rug that contained stains and debris located in front of a set of cubbies in Classroom A; therefore, the rug was not kept clean.
- 3. A blue/green square turtle rug that contained debris in Classroom A; therefore, the rug was not kept clean.

### 690 - Sink **Not In Compliance**

# 922 KAR 2:120. Section 12. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

- (3) A sink shall be:
- (a) Located in or immediately adjacent to toilet rooms:
- (b) Equipped with hot and cold running water that allows for hand washing;
- (c) Equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit;
- (d) Equipped with liquid soap;
- (e) Equipped with hand-drying blower or single use disposable hand drying material;
- (f) Equipped with an easily cleanable waste receptacle; and
- (g) Immediately adjacent to a changing area used for infants and toddlers.

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. The hot water temperature in the restroom located between the Early Head Start B Classroom and Head Start B Classroom measured approximately 125 degrees Fahrenheit; therefore, the hot water was not a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit.
- 2. The hot water temperature at the sink located in the Head Start B Classroom measured approximately 125 degrees Fahrenheit; therefore, the hot water was not a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit.
- 3. The cold water temperature in the restroom located between the Early Head Start B Classroom and Head Start B Classroom measured approximately 125 degrees Fahrenheit; therefore, the restroom was not equipped with cold running water that allows for handwashing.

- 1. A staff's (DOH: 01/02/19) file contained a professional development plan dated for 08/03/20; therefore, the plan was not completed annually.
- 2. A staff's (DOH: 01/02/19) file contained a professional development plan dated for 09/01/20; therefore, the plan was not completed annually.

Through interview with staff-in-charge, the surveyor learned that up-to-date annual professional development plans were not available for review for the staff mentioned.
