922 KAR 2:120. Section 3. General Requirements.

- (12) A fire drill shall be:
- (a) Conducted during hours of operation at least monthly; and
- (b) Documented.
- (13) An earthquake drill, shelter-in-place or lockdown drill, and tornado drill shall be:
- (a) Conducted during hours of operation at least quarterly; and
- (b) Documented.

Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, the child-care center did not complete earthquake, tornado, and lockdown drills as required.

The surveyor found that an earthquake drill was conducted on 5/10/2021, and a tornado drill was conducted on 5/11/2021. The staff person stated that she conducts drills in conjunction with the school system. She indicated that the school was going to conduct drills next week. Furthermore, there was no documentation of lockdown/shelter-in-place drills.

- (f) Minimum staff-to-child ratios and group size established in 922 KAR 2:120; and
- (g) Daily planned program.

General: Based on observation, information about the Kentucky Consumer Product Safety Program was not posted or available for review.
