Staff reported that she would make sure staff completes the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training by 06/30 of the current year.

 - f. Authorization by the parent for the child-care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found that a child's (DOE: 09/13/2019) file was missing the preferred hospital and phone number, along with the preferred physician and phone number.

Staff reported that she would have the child's parent to update the preferred hospital and physician information, along with their contact information.
