(c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

(17) A staff person's compliance with training requirements of this section shall be verified through the cabinet-designated database maintained pursuant to 922 KAR 2:240.

General: Based on review of documentation and ECE-TRIS, the surveyor found that staff (DOH: 04/12/2019) completed zero (0) hours of the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinetapproved early care and education training during the timeframe of 07/01/2020 and 06/30/2021.
