She stated that after putting the breakfast items away she also did some prep work for lunch by placing a pot on the stove. She stated that the stove was never turned on in the presence of the children. She stated that after approximately ten minutes she took the children back to their classroom. Based on this information, it was determined that the children could not be adequately supervised while the teacher was in the kitchen.</p> | |
