Findings: General: Based on interview, this regulatory requirement was not met. A two-year-old child's fingernail was trimmed by a staff member at the child-care facility. It was learned during interview that a two-year-old child had a long, jagged fingernail and the child accidentally scratched another child with the nail. The staff member indicated that she trimmed the long, jagged nail with child nail clippers. The staff member did not have permission from the parent to trim the fingernail. **Hygienic Practices** In Compliance **Children's Records** Not In Compliance 1135 - Immunization Not In Compliance 922 KAR 2:090. Section 9. Records. (1) A child-care center shall maintain: (a) A current immunization certificate for each child in care within thirty (30) days of the child's enrollment, unless an attending physician or the child's parent objects to the immunization of the child pursuant to KRS 214.036; Findings: General: Based on observation and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. A child's file did not contain an immunization certificate. The child had been enrolled in excess of thirty days.



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
