**(b) The age of the youngest child in the group shall determine the:**

**Findings:**

General: Based on observation, at approximately 12:01 p.m., the surveyor found one staff person and six children ages three- to twelve-months-old present in the infant classroom. Therefore, the infant classroom was over-ratio by one child. The staff person stated that she had been over-ratio for approximately 30 minutes, because a second staff person was assisting with staff breaks. The second staff person entered the classroom at 12:07 p.m., and confirmed that she had been gone for approximately 30 minutes.

<b>Findings:</b>  General: Based on observation, the surveyor found a three-month-old infant sleeping in a crib; propped on a boppy pillow. Interviews with staff found that the infant requires an alternate sleep position due to a medical condition. A written request from a health professional was not on file.
