Based on observation, it was found that there were numerous pest control traps placed on the floor in the kitchen. The kitchen door was open, therefore these traps were accessible to the children in care.

Findings:

Based on observation, the kitchen door was propped open at the beginning of the inspection visit. There was a knife found in an unlocked kitchen drawer. Due to the door being propped open, this was accessible to the children in care.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the following was found:

- 1) A large vent located in a hallway was not securely attached to the wall leaving a large gap between the vent and the wall. This vent was accessible to the children.
- 2) There were pieces of peaches found in a dust pan that was on the floor of the Orange classroom. The dust pan was accessible to the children.
