Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, a caregiver placed a one-year-old toddler in a highchair and a second child on the diaper changing table in the nursey. During the diaper change of the second child, the caregiver observed the toddler stand up in the highchair, fall forward onto the floor, and hit the left side of his face on the floor at 11:30 am on 08/25/20. The child received medical care for a swollen, discolored left eye.

685 - Diaper Changing Area/Surface

- 4. Nonabsorbent;
- 5. Easily cleaned; and
- 6. Free of any items not used for diaper changing.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, a half-inch tear was on the surface of the diaper changing mat in the nursery.

820 - Indoor/Outdoor Equipment Not In Compliance

- (2) Indoor and outdoor equipment shall:
- (a) Be clean, safe, and in good repair;
- (b) Meet the physical, developmental needs, and interests of children of different age groups;
- (c) Be free from sharp points or corners, splinters, protruding nails or bolts, loose or rusty parts, hazardous small parts, lead-based paint, poisonous material, and flaking or chalking paint; and
- (d) Be designed to guard against entrapment or situations that may cause strangulation.

General: Based on observation, a ceiling light was not operable in the nursery.

- f. Authorization by the parent for the child-care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence;

General: Based on review of documentation, a child enrolled 7/29/19,did not have authorization by the parent for the child-care center to seek emergency care for the child in the parent absence.
