## 1255 - Emergency Regulation

922 KAR 2:405E. Emergency Regulation.

Due to the current declared public health emergency caused by the Novel Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19), licensed child care centers must operate under Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and public health guidelines, as mandated by 922 KAR 2:405E, to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

#### Findings:

General: Based on observation, interview and review of documentation, the center failed to assure new staff shall undergo name-based background in accordance with 922 KAR 2:280 and shall not be left alone with children until name-based background checks have been approved and returned, in accordance with 922 KAR 2:405E Section 11(5). A caregiver hired on 3/6/20, did not have name based background checks on file.
