- (b)1. Have submitted to the background checks required in accordance with this administrative regulation;
- 2. Not be left unsupervised with a child in care pending the completion of the background checks in accordance with this administrative regulation: and
- 3. Be dismissed or relocated from the residence if the person is found to have a disqualifying background check result.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, it was found that one staff member did not have a CAN or CRC on file at the facility. During the inspection, the director showed the surveyor that she had the forms ready to be mailed and reported that she was going to drop them in the mail that day. The staff member was hired on 10/28/2020; therefore, the CAN and CRC were not submitted upon the date of hire. It is important to note that this staff member is a cook only and does not have any supervisory role over the children.

General: Based on review of documentation, one staff person did not have evidence of an annual performance evaluation on file at the facility.

Based on observation, two staff members did not have proof of education of file at the facility. The dates of hire for these staff are 09/28/2020 and 10/10/2020.

410 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, it was found that one staff person did not complete orientation training within the ninety-day timeframe. The staff member was hired on 12/27/2019, and the training was not completed until 06/26/2020. A review of ECE-TRIS confirmed this finding.

General: Based on observation, it was found that there was a floor vent in the toddler one classroom that was in disrepair and was repaired with duct tape.

(9) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, in good repair, and constructed to be easily cleaned.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the following was found:

- 1.) In the toddler one classroom, there was an area of the wall underneath the soap dispenser where there was a large area of missing paint.
- 2.) In the nursery classroom, there were three small holes in the wall.
- 3.) In the toddler two classroom, the bottom part of the walls are carpeted. There was an area where the carpet was beginning to pull away from the wall. 4.) In the preschool classroom, there was an area of missing paint on the wall where there was an artwork paper turkey displayed.
- 5.) In the tiny tots classroom, there were areas of the wall that looked as if something had been ripped off the wall, which left areas of missing paint.

- 3.) In the playschool classroom, there was a rug that was dirty with stains. 4.) In the toddler one classroom, there were shelves in the classroom that contained a lot of tape residue.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, it was found that one child's file only contained an immunization certificate. The file did not contain any enrollment paperwork; therefore, no identifying/parent information, emergency authorization, preferred hospital, physician contact, authorized pick-up, or medical information was provided for this child. There was also no date of enrollment for this child.

General: Based on review of documentation, it was found that one staff person did not have an annual professional development plan on file at the facility.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, it was found that there was no evidence of fire drills being completed at the facility in July, August, and October of 2020. In addition, it was found that there was no evidence of an earthquake or tornado drill being completed in the first quarter of 2020.

1195 - Fire Drills Not In Compliance

- (a) Conducted during hours of operation at least monthly; and
- (b) Documented.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, it was found that there was no evidence of fire drills being completed at the facility in July, August, and October of 2020. In addition, it was found that there was no evidence of an earthquake or tornado drill being completed in the first quarter of 2020.

- 2.) There was a sink located in the preschool classroom. The handwashing procedure was not posted anywhere in this classroom.
