## Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, the child care center failed to maintain state regulations. Review of presented documentation found the Fire Marshal inspection report was dated 02/17/2020. An interview with the facility director found current documentation was not available at the time of the survey.

### 225 - Licensee Responsibility

## 922 KAR 2:090. Section 8. General.

(1) A licensee shall:

(a) Be responsible for the operation of the child-care center pursuant to this administrative regulation, 922 KAR 2:120, and 922 KAR 2:280; and (b) Protect and assure the health, safety, and comfort of each child.

## Findings:

General: Based on observation, the child care center failed to maintain state regulations. During the survey, the Preschool bathroom contained an uncovered electrical wall outlet, located directly to the left of the sink used for handwashing.

## 400 - Educational Requirements

#### 922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

#### (1) Child-care center staff:

- (a) Hired after January 1, 2009, who have supervisory power over a minor and are not enrolled in secondary education, shall have a: 1. High school diploma:
- 2. GED or qualifying documentation from a comparable educational entity; or
- 3. Commonwealth Child Care Credential as described in 922 KAR 2:250;

### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the child care center failed to maintain state regulations. Upon review of staff files, it was found that an employee with a hire date of 02/21/2022, did not have proof of the required educational requirements.

## 435 - Training

## 922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

(16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:

(a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program; (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one

and one-half (1  $\frac{1}{2}$ ) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each

subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 1/2) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

(17) A staff person's compliance with training requirements of this section shall be verified through the cabinet-designated database maintained pursuant to 922 KAR 2:240.

#### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the child care center failed to maintain state regulations. A review of the Early Care and Education Training Records Information System (ECE-TRIS) report and employee files, it was found that current employees with the date of hire 08/22/2019, 09/06/2021, 08/30/2021, and 08/16/2021, did not have the required 15 hours of training for the year. In addition, it was found that one employee with a hire date of 02/21/2022, did not have the required Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma Training. This staff member has been employed longer than one year.

#### 540 - Bedding/Toys in Crib

## 922 KAR 2:120. Section 6. Sleeping and Napping Requirements. (3) Rest time shall occur in an adequate space according to the child's age as follows: (a) For an infant: 3. No bedding other than a clean tight-fitted sheet; and

4. No toys or other items except the infant's pacifier;

#### Findings:

General: Based on observation, the child care center failed to maintain state regulations. During the survey of the Infant room, it was found that one (1) infant was lying in a crib with a pacifier that had a clip attached to it. Premises

### 625 - Floors, Walls, Ceilings

### 922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

(9) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, in good repair, and constructed to be easily cleaned.

## Findings:

General: Based on observation, the child care center failed to maintain state regulations. The Preschool bathroom, contained a small hole exposing the drywall. This hole was just above the sink, and slightly to the right.

(b) Each statement of deficiency and civil penalty notice issued by the cabinet during the current licensure year;

(c) Each plan of correction submitted by the child-care center to the cabinet during the current licensure year;

(d) Information on the Kentucky Consumer Product Safety Program and the program's Web site as specified in KRS 199.897;

(e) A description of services provided by the child-care center, including:

1. Current rates for child care; and

2. Each service charged separately and in addition to the basic rate for child care;

(f) Minimum staff-to-child ratios and group size established in 922 KAR 2:120; and

(g) Daily planned program.

## Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, the child care facility failed to maintain state regulations. It was found that the child care facility did not have a copy of the information pertaining to Kentucky Consumer Product Safety posted for review.
