General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

1. A piece of metal, approximately three (3) by two (2) feet in size, contained sharp edges and was located on the ground at the entrance of the child care center.

2. A metal handrail was located on the ground at the entrance of the child care center.

3. Two (2) extension cords were placed on the ground at the entrance to the child care center.

Staff reported the items would be removed.

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

(1) Child-care center staff:

(a) Hired after January 1, 2009, who have supervisory power over a minor and are not enrolled in secondary education, shall have a: 1. High school diploma:

- 2. GED or qualifying documentation from a comparable educational entity; or
- 3. Commonwealth Child Care Credential as described in 922 KAR 2:250;

Findings:

General: Based on interview with staff, the surveyor learned that the staff's (DOH: 01/19/2022) file did not contain a copy of a high school diploma, GED, or Commonwealth Child Care Credential; therefore, the surveyor was unable to verify the staff's education.

Staff reported she would obtain a copy of the staff's educational documentation for the file.

405 - TB Verification

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

(1) Child-care center staff:

(b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:

1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or

2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found that staff (DOH: 11/29/2021) file did not contain a copy of a statement from a health care professional stating the individual was free of active tuberculosis or a copy of a negative tuberculin results for the staff person; therefore, the surveyor was unable to verify if the staff person was free of active tuberculosis.

Staff reported she would obtain a copy of the staff's TB skin test.

435 - Training

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

(16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:

(a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program; (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one

and one-half (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and

(c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 1/2) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

(17) A staff person's compliance with training requirements of this section shall be verified through the cabinet-designated database maintained pursuant to 922 KAR 2:240.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and ECE-TRIS, the surveyor found the following:

1. Staff (DOH: 09/07/2009) has completed nine and one-third (9 1/3) of the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1st and the following June 30th.

2. Staff (DOH: 06/01/2014) has completed four and one-half (4 1/2) of the required fifteen (15) of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1st and the following June 30th.

Staff reported the staff completed the training hours. Staff stated she would check to see why the training hours are not reflected in ECE-TRIS.
