The surveyor toured the preschool classroom during the visit and observed a phone jack faceplate that was hanging loose/not securly attached. The staff person in charge used scotch tape during the visit to secure it to the wall.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. During a tour of the infant classroom the surveyor observed a round hole, approximately one (1) inch in diameter, in the floor beside the refrigerator.

922 KAR 2:120. Section 11. Toys and Furnishings.

- (2) Indoor and outdoor equipment shall:
- (a) Be clean, safe, and in good repair;
- (b) Meet the physical, developmental needs, and interests of children of different age groups;
- (c) Be free from sharp points or corners, splinters, protruding nails or bolts, loose or rusty parts, hazardous small parts, lead-based paint, poisonous material, and flaking or chalking paint; and
- (d) Be designed to guard against entrapment or situations that may cause strangulation.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The following was found:

1. During a tour of the outdoor playground the surveyor observed a blue riding scooter that was is dis-repair. The plastic surface where the children sit contained a large crack across the top.

2. Surveyor observede a pop-up blanket toy in the infant classroom that contained numerous spots and stains.

3. Two (2) excersausers in the infant classroom were un-clean. One (1) contained numerous dirt/sand particles in the base and the other contained dirt particles and a sticky residue in the cracks and crevices of the top surface surface.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, this regulatory requirement was not met. The surveyor found that the facility has yet to establish their emergency preparedness plan according to KRS 199.895. The staff person in charge stated that she was not aware that it needed to be submitted during the change of ownership process.
