Findings:

General: Based on observation, the following was found:

1.) On the playground used by the Head Start classrooms, there were areas on the playground where the black underpinning was exposed. This causes a tripping hazard to the children using the playground.

2.) On the smaller playground used by the early Head Start children, there were weeds that needed to be pulled. As well, there was a lack of grass in a certain area, which resulted in mud and the ground being exposed.
