922 KAR 2:120. Section 10. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.
(3) A sink shall be:
(a) Located in or immediately adjacent to toilet rooms;
(b) Equipped with hot and cold running water that allows for hand washing;
(c) Equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit;
(d) Equipped with liquid soap;
(e) Equipped with hand-drying blower or single use disposable hand drying material;
(f) Equipped with an easily cleanable waste receptacle; and
(g) Immediately adjacent to a changing area used for infants and toddlers.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the hot water temperature at three (3) handwashing sinks registered seventy-eight (78) degrees Fahrenheit.

650 - Toilet **Not In Compliance**

922 KAR 2:120. Section 10. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.
(4) Each toilet shall:
(a) Be kept in clean condition;
(b) Be kept in good repair;
(c) Be in a lighted room; and
(d) Have ventilation to outside air.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, a restroom, across from the infants' room, did not have ventilation to outside air.
