General: Based on observation, it was found that the children were being served chicken nuggets, potato chips and a juice drink for lunch. The juice drink was not 100% juice. The potato chips and the juice drink do not meet the requirements to be considered a component for lunch. Therefore, the children were served only one component for lunch on the day of the investigation.
