Findings: General: Based on interview, it was found that the children were served milk and cereal for breakfast on the day of the investigation. A third component was not served to the children in care.	
995 - Lunch/Dinner Requirements	Not In Compliance
922 KAR 2:120. Section 9. Food and Meal Requirements. (19) Lunch and dinner shall include: (a) Milk; (b) Protein; (c) Bread; and (d) 1. Two (2) vegetables; 2. Two (2) fruits; or 3. One (1) fruit and one (1) vegetable.	
Findings: General: Based on observation, it was found that the children were being served chicken nuggets, potato chips and a juice drink for lunch. The juice drink was not 100% juice. The potato chips and the juice drink do not meet the requirements to be considered a component for lunch. Therefore, the children were served only one component for lunch on the day of the investigation.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, it was found that the children were being served chicken nuggets, potato chips and a juice drink for lunch. These items were not listed on the facility's menu for lunch on the day of the investigation.
