Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, three (3) staff members hired 5/15/20, 10/30/19, and 03/05/21, did not have first aid and (CPR) training.

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, two (2) staff members hired 07/15/20 and 10/30/19, failed to complete the fifteen (15) hours of cabinet approved training hours from July 1 to June 30 of their subsequent year of employment. In addition, a staff member hired 10/30/19 completed two and a half (2 1/2) hours of the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet approved training during their subsequent year of employment. In addition, two (2) staff members hired 07/15/20 and 03/05/21, had no proof they completed six (6) hours of orientation training.
