(I) Assure the health, safety, and comfort of each child;

Findings:

Based on observation and interview, this regulatory requirement was not met. Interviews confirmed that on 12/4/19, a two-year-old female received medical treatment and was diagnosed with a dislocated elbow. It was reported that the child had difficulty in moving her left arm when her mother attempted to put her coat on and she would not let her mother pick her up. The child was then taken to the emergency room. Prior to receiving medical treatment, the child was in the care of the facility. Interviews confirmed that there were two separate incidents wherein the child might have been injured. During the first incident, the female child was playing with a toy on a shelf when a male child came up to her and pushed her, causing her to fall to her hands and knees. The male child then placed his body on top of the female pushing her to her stomach with her arms underneath her. The staff reported removing the male child and the female child started to sit up. The staff person picked the female child up in her arms and sat down in a chair. The staff person indicated that the female would not allow her to put her back down. Additional interviews found that the male child has persistently shown aggressive behavior to the other children.

In the second incident, the same female child was observed standing on a cushion and hanging from a basketball goal (approximately four feet in height) while playing in the gross motor room. At that time, the same male child from the first incident kicked the cushion out from under the female child, causing her to fall backwards.

- (4) The child-care center shall provide a daily planned program:
- (a) Posted in writing in a conspicuous location with each age group and followed;
- (b) Of activities that are individualized and developmentally appropriate for each child served;
- (c) That provides experience to promote the individual child's physical, emotional, social, and intellectual growth and well-being; and
- (d) Unless the child-care center is a before- or after-school program that operates part day or less, that offers a variety of creative activities including:
- 1. Art or music;
- 2. Math or numbers;
- 3. Dramatic play;
- 4. Stories and books;
- 5. Science or nature;
- 6. Block building or stacking;
- 7. Tactile or sensory activity;
- 8. Multi-cultural exposure;
- 9. Indoor or outdoor play in which a child makes use of both small and large muscles;
- 10. A balance of active and quiet play, including group and individual activity;
- 11. An opportunity for a child to:
- a. Have some free choice of activities;
- b. If desired, play apart from the group at times;

Findings:

Based on the interviews, it was confirmed that the safety of the children in care was compromised when a two-year-old child received an injury (dislocated elbow) at some point while in the care of the facility. On the same day the injury was diagnosed, the child was first pushed down and then fell backwards after being knocked off a cushion by a male child who has demonstrated aggressive behavior to children.
