- (b) The child care staff member shall:
- 1. Have no more than ninety (90) calendar days from the date of payment pursuant to subsections (2) and (3) of this section to submit the child care staff member's fingerprints at an authorized collection site for NBCP; and
- 2. Present the DCC-504 and driver's license or other government-issued photo identification to the designated agent at an authorized collection site prior to fingerprint submission.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, the child care center failed to comply with the regulatory requirements regarding background checks. A review of records revealed the child care center had not submitted fingerprints to an authorized collection site for the Kentucky National Background Check Program (NBCP) on behalf of a staff member with a hire date of 2/7/19 (the staff member was not observed working alone with children at the child care center).

- (e) A description of services provided by the child-care center, including:
- 1. Current rates for child care; and
- 2. Each service charged separately and in addition to the basic rate for child care;
- (f) Minimum staff-to-child ratios and group size established in 922 KAR 2:120; and
- (g) Daily planned program.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the child care center failed to post documentation in accordance with regulations. Observation of the child care center revealed that there was no posted description of services provided, including current rates for child care as well as each service charged separately in addition to the basic rate for child care.
